# Accelerate Tuberculosis Elimination and Program Resilience Activity

### *Accelerate 1's core partner and their expertise*

#### *The Aurum Institute:*

*Aurum is a scientific and programmatic leader in TB, with a deep understanding of the science and implementation approaches that lead to successful epidemic control.*

*The Aurum Institute will be supported by its community partner mothers2mothers.*

The Accelerate TB Elimination and Program Resilience Activity (ACCELERATE) supports South Africa's efforts to achieve TB elimination through early detection, appropriate treatment and care, and prevention among vulnerable populations, particularly those infected with drug susceptible TB (DS-TB), drug resistant TB (DR-TB), or TB/HIV co-infection.

ACCELERATE is the flagship USAID/SA TB project which comprises two separate activities. ACCELERATE 1 targets technical support and interventions at the national level, the provincial level and in high TB burden districts. ACCELERATE 2 targets technical support and interventions at the provincial level and in lower TB burden districts. The two activities will collaborate and partner together to support the achievement of TB elimination in South Africa.

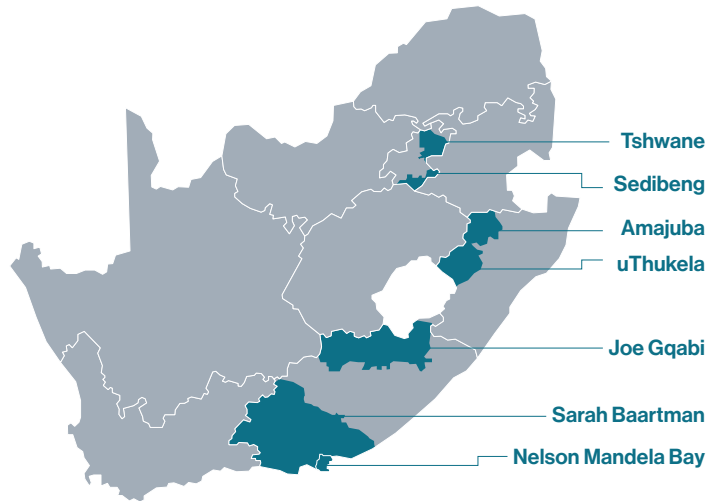


## Accelerate 1's four main objectives



ACCELERATE 1 total estimated amount is \$47,000,000 implemented by The Aurum Institute in Gauteng (Tshwane and Sedibeng districts), KwaZulu-Natal (Uthukela and Amajuba districts), and the Eastern Cape (Nelson Mandela Bay, Joe Gqabi, and on September 1, 2023, and is scheduled to end on August 31, 2028.

ACCELERATE 2's total estimated amount is \$47,000,000 and it will be implemented in the Free State (Mangaung and Fezile Dabi districts), Limpopo (Vhembe and Sekhukhune districts), Western Cape (West Coast and Cape Winelands districts), and Mpumalanga (Nkangala district).



## The Aurum ACCELERATE Implementation Model

**Aurum and community partner mothers2mothers (m2m) have designed the following implementation model that offers five unique capabilities in accelerating TB elimination:**

**Efforts will focus on strengthening site level delivery** through data use, capacity building in the use of innovation and evidence-based best practice, community DSD and QI.
